## Subject: Election of the CIML First Vice-President at the 40<sup>th</sup> CIML Meeting

As explained in BIML Circular no. 05/120 dated 7 January 2005, the CIML will elect a First Vice-President at its 40<sup>th</sup> Meeting in Lyon.
