Subject: Nominations for OIML Awards to be made at the 41st CIML Meeting

Dear Colleagues,

As in previous years, the CIML President will present OIML Awards to individuals who have made an outstanding contribution to international legal metrology.

There are two types of Awards:

- Specially engraved Medals (not more than three of which are given out each year) in recognition of an individual's distinguished contribution over several years; and
- Letters of Appreciation (also not more than three per year), in recognition of an individual's contribution over the past year that merits special recognition and public acknowledgment.

Active CIML Members are not eligible for either of the awards.

If you have identified any individuals to whom you feel the OIML should make an award, I invite you to send me your nomination(s) accompanied by a short note explaining your motivations. I will examine your proposals and make decisions on the recipients that will receive an award in Cape Town.

Your proposals should be sent to the BIML no later than **August 31st**.
