Revision of ISO 3930/OIML R 99 *Instruments for measuring vehicle exhaust emissions*

*Part 3: Report Format*

Dear Colleagues,

CIML Members are now invited to vote in a preliminary online ballot on the revision of Draft Standard ISO 3930/Draft OIML Recommendation OIML R 99-1 and 2, and on Draft OIML Recommendation OIML R 99-3. The relevant documents have been uploaded onto the Members Page of the OIML web site in the form of two WinZip files.

The OIML TC 3/SC 5 Secretariat will then draw up the final Draft Recommendations based on any comments received from CIML Members. The final DRs will be submitted to the CIML at its 43rd meeting in October 2008, provided that the result of the present CIML ballot is favorable.

According to 3.5.1 of Part 1 of the OIML Directives for the Technical Work, a four-month consultation period should be allowed for CIML Members to post their comments.

At the request of the TC 16/SC 1 Secretariat, in this case it is suggested to **reduce this consultation period to two months** in order to be able to draw up the synthesis of comments and, if appropriate, to modify the Draft in advance of the CIML Meeting. In addition, such a time schedule would improve the consistency of the two different approval processes in ISO and in the OIML in order to have the joint Publication published by the two Organizations at the same time.

Consequently, the deadline for votes and comments (corresponding to the CIML Preliminary Online Ballot) is fixed at **30 September 2008**.
